

**NEW CALL FOR AUTHORIZING PROPOSALS FOR «ΚΑΛΛΙΠΟΣ+»**

**CALL 2026-B. Translations of existing books. During the period 1/1/2026-31/12/2026, up to 50 translations will be funded.**

- Submission period: **10/12/2025-10/2/2026**. After that period, the Call will remain open until the budget is exhausted or a new project is approved.
- Beneficiaries: Authors of the books, or suitable translators.
- Funding: up to 5000 euros for the translation.
- Procedure:
  1. Interested parties submit an “expression of interest” with a request to <https://helpdesk.kallipos.gr/> and the title “**CALL 2026-B Translation of a book**”. The request must include:
    - (a) details of the use of the existing book in undergraduate and/or postgraduate courses. The use is certified by mentioning the book on official course websites and/or in the official Course Catalogue of the Institution.
    - (b) reference to thematically related courses, which are offered within the framework of existing study programs and in which the translated book could be used.
  2. The request is evaluated by the Central Support Team (CST). The evaluation will be based on the data provided by the author in step (1), as well as on the use of the work (views, downloads), as recorded in the KALLIPOS Repository.
  3. The evaluated proposals are classified into two categories, of first- and second-priority, based on the above data. The tables of the two categories are posted on the Project Website, and a relevant announcement is made on the page of each work in the Repository.
  4. The proposals of the first category are contracted immediately, with a deadline of 30/9/2026. The decision on the approval of the second-priority proposals will be postponed until the end of the submission period.
  5. The authors submit the primary material, which is evaluated by the Scientific Committee.
  6. With a positive evaluation in step 5:
    - (a) If a contract already exists (from step 4), half of the expected fee is paid to the authoring/translation team.
    - (b) Otherwise, a relevant contract is concluded and half of the amount stipulated is paid in the shortest possible time.
  7. The Linguistic and Technical processing of the book follows by the CST, in collaboration with the authors/translators.
  8. The authors/translators will be paid after the completion of the Technical processing.
  9. The library processing and posting in the Repository are carried out.
